



17th FINA World Masters Championships 2017 Budapest Hungary

Graham Ling represented Hythe Aqua and GBR at these Championships which were held in August. The event was held at Lake Balaton. The freshwater lake is quite shallow and the quality of water is excellent.

The promenade on the lakeside is one of the most beautiful around the Balaton. At the western peak of the lake, you can find one of the largest natural biologically active thermal water lakes of the world in Hévíz.

Graham swam in the 3000m race on Day 1 of the Open Water Championships. The course was three laps with Graham finishing in a time of 1hr :11m :16.6secs. Graham was the Top Brit in his Age Group and really put Hythe Aqua on the World Stage, finishing in 13th place. Graham said it was a hard race with several swimmers completing the course in a similar time making the final race to the finish very hard and competitive.
