A small group of Hythe Aqua swimmers entered this Open and did the Club proud with 17 Pb's and others getting very close to their Pb's.

Kyla Alecks, a new entrant to squads, showed her potential by winning the 9yrs 100m Breaststroke, the first time she had ever swam it, in a very fast time beating the opposition by 20 secs. She then followed it up with an 8 second PB to gain 4th place in the 50m free,

The Breaststroke successes continued with Taylor Russell getting 4th in the 10yr 100m with a 7 sec PB and Thomas Lambert 7th in the same event with a strong Pb. Rosie Aireton-Brown swam new Pbs for 6th in the 10yr 100m Breast and in her 50m Breast whilst Mackenzie Lambert's 4 sec PB achieved 7th in the 100m 13yr age gp. In the 50m Breast Connor Alecks swam a fantastic 39.21 for 4th in the 13ys age group

Kiera Chase had a great day showing that older swimmers still have it with 2nd in the 50m Free, 3rd 50m Back, 6th 50m Fly and a PB in her 50m Breast. A newcomer to open events Ethan Bedford got 2 good pbs in the 50 and 100m Free, Maeve Keating 50m Fly/50mFree both excellent PB's and another for Laura Leon-Kolodzief in the 100m Free. MacKenzie and Thomas Lambert achieved PB's in their 50m Free and Tristan Parmenter in the 100m Back.
